



<sup>1</sup> The MSP estimates that it sends an average of 500 reports to disaster victims each week. An advance may be granted for an individual or business owner for emergency work, temporary work, or work to repair a principal residence or essential building, in an amount representing up to 70% of the estimated financial assistance amount payable for the work (amount estimated in the report).

<sup>2</sup> The owner has twelve (12) months to complete the work after receiving a written notice, or after the date when the owner made his or her choice, if applicable, with the Minister, due to the imminence of erosion, submersion, or ground movements. This deadline cannot be extended unless the accident victim demonstrates that it is impossible to comply. This deadline is also contingent on permits being issued and contractors being available.
